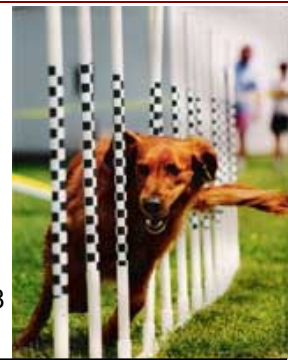

Useful Tips: Excessive/Nonsense barking. Water spray bottle can be a simple aid for excessive/nonsense barking. You can also shake a tin can with pennies inside of it. Spray the water or rattle the can to distract the dog when it is barking. Give a command that the dog can learn each time you use the deterrent such as “quiet” or “no bark”. You need to be persistent with the command and the deterrent. You can also try to use a product such as Bitter Apple to aid in this training.

Pretty Paws Care Tips:

During the winter months dog owners tend to leave their dogs hair longer. If this is the case it is important to continue to brush and comb your dog to prevent matting. A comb should be used in conjunction with a brush. The brush tends to brush through the surface hair but does not always reach the base of the hair near the skin where mats can also form. The comb will reach the base of the hair for more mat prevention. Mats near the skin are difficult to remove and many times need to be clipped out.

December Topic of Importance:

Now that we are moving strong into the winter weather be sure to be careful with salt use on sidewalks and driveways.

Sidewalk salt can be harmful to your dog. The salt can be irritating to your dog’s pads and the dogs can also ingest the salt when licking their paws.

There are many salt-free products available for use.

Safe Paw is one product that is recommended. We do have it available in our retail store.

Whichever product you decide to use, please check the label thoroughly to make sure it is safe for pets.
