Pretty Paws Care Tips:

Removal of a dog's undercoat is important during this time of the year. The undercoat is another coat that dogs have during the cold winter months but now we need to help them shed it out.

Combing your dog or using a product such as the Furbuster can help remove this undercoat.

July Topic of Importance:

Summer Heat – Your dog can over heat during the hot summer days. Please be sure to be very observant to your dog's needs during the hot weather. **NEVER** leave your dog in a hot vehicle for any length of time during hot summer days. Even if you leave windows cracked open, your dog can still suffer from heat exhaustion, stroke or worse. Insides of vehicles heat up very quickly and can cause heat related problems for your dog. When traveling with your dog make sure your dog can be taken out of the vehicle when you have reached your destination. Have cool water available at all times. For example, water can be stored in a cooler to be kept chilled. There are many varieties of portable watering dishes available for your dog, which are very helpful. Allow your dog a shady area to rest and stay cool if it is outside. While at home, your dog may enjoy a little dip in a cool kiddie pool. Refresh the water periodically. Limit vigorous activity with your dog during the hottest part of the summer days. If you are uncomfortable due to the summer heat, you can bet that your dog is feeling the same. Keep your dog in mind during the hot dog days of summer.

As we progressed through Beginning and Advanced Obedience, Joan was able to give me many tips on how to change her behavior and how I could communicate more effectively with Poco. We're not perfect but Poco and I have come along way.

The Beginning Agility was so much fun! At first I didn't believe that we could do this. Poco learned to go over small jumps, up an A-frame, through tunnels, over a Teeter Totter, and a cat walk all off line. At first you just can't believe that you can trust your dog to follow the instructions off line, but they get really excited about the game and want to perform well. She loves it. We would be much better if I could be in the right place at the right time, but that will come. If you are thinking about Agility for you and your dog - I would recommend the classes.
